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1. Project Summary and Introduction

The word region is defined as “an area, especially part of a country or the world having definable characteristics but not always fixed boundaries”¹. The Baltic Sea region (BSR) is particularly unique. While the Baltic Sea is the pivotal point defining much of the region’s characteristics and challenges, the countries are also extremely different. Geographically, they are divided between Northern, Western and Central/Eastern Europe, historically, they have been shaped by the East-West divide after the second world war. Nevertheless, given their proximity to the Baltic Sea, they have much in common.

The EU has acknowledged this by issuing the very first macro-regional strategy, the EU Baltic Sea Region Strategy in 2009. As most countries boarding the Baltic Sea were by then EU member states, it can well be considered the EU’s inland sea. The challenges, such as saving the sea, i.e. ensuring clear water, rich and healthy wildlife as well as clean and safe shipping, and the opportunities for a prosperous region through cooperation measures to increase innovation, deepen the single market by improving transportation systems, connecting energy markets and fighting trans-border crime together, make the region very distinct from other parts of the world. Therefore, “BSR integration is best understood as the way that European integration has been translated into this region, further deepening and leveraging access to the rest of Europe and the markets that the EU provides”²

Over the past 25 years, this region has become a densely integrated, e.g. in the areas of trade, investment, labor mobility, transport and energy infrastructure as well as research collaboration. Furthermore, it demonstrates a broad landscape of robust cross-border organizations and collaborative efforts. Nevertheless, “companies do not look at the Baltic Sea Region as one integrated market in terms of their strategies. For most of them, the region remains a group of individually small markets within the EU, each with its different dynamics, rivals, and often even regulatory rules”³.

Keeping this in mind, the lack of comprehensive regional data collection is surprising. Therefore, as part of the Erasmus+ funded project “Promoting permeability through dual bachelor's programs with integrated initial and further vocational training” (BA&VET), an analysis of the region’s demography, economy, and labour as well as education market has been conducted. The majority of the data is taken from the Eurostat database of the European Union. When needed additional sources, such as the OECD database, have been consulted as well.

1.1 Project summary

Objectives: What do you want to achieve by implementing the project?

1.2 Objectives, results and target groups

The main objectives of the project are as follows:

- a) Increasing the permeability between vocational education and training and higher education and thus promoting the attractiveness of vocational education and training
- b) Strengthening the recruitment of colleges/universities for the important tasks of continuing education in climate and environmental protection
- c) Providing highly qualified entrepreneurs, managers and skilled workers who, in addition to good theoretical knowledge, also have practical competences, skills and professional experience in climate and environmental protection and reducing the shortage of skilled workers to cope with the very large tasks in the energy, climate and environmental sector.
- d) Attracting entrepreneurs and executives who have all the skills to successfully run a company and perform high-quality tasks in climate and environmental protection
- e) Strengthening the productivity and competitiveness of enterprises through knowledge and technology transfer, promotion of innovation and implementation of manageable R&D projects
- f) promoting cooperation between SMEs and colleges/universities, strengthening colleges/universities to implement dual courses of study on climate and environmental protection, and promoting entrepreneurship in higher education.

In pursuit of these objectives, the following results will be achieved:

1. Analysis results on the economy, demography, education and labour markets as well as qualification needs in climate and environmental protection
2. Curriculum, Teaching materials, implementation report and evaluation concept and report for teacher training
3. Module handbooks with integrated continuing education, teaching materials, examination regulations, implementation reports as well as evaluation concept and reports for a three-stage dual Bachelor's degree program
 - Business Administration and Sustainable Management for SMEs
 - Management of Renewable Energy Technology in Buildings
4. Concept for promoting innovation by SMEs and evaluation concept and report
5. Concept for innovation promotion of SMEs and R&D projects carried out for SMEs
6. Concepts and report for the evaluation and quality assurance of qualifications and

R&D subsidies as well as project implementation, transfer of results, implementations and implementation consultations

The primary target groups of the project are:

- a) school leavers who wish to combine vocational education and training with a bachelor's degree and thus receive excellent employment and professional career opportunities.
- b) students who are qualified in higher education and university and at the same time in a company and who are highly welcome in SMEs as managers and professionals or as independent entrepreneurs.
- c) owners, managers and specialists of SMEs who are qualified in continuing vocational training, acquire tailor-made competences and skills for high-quality activities in climate and environmental protection and achieve a recognized continuing vocational qualification.
- d) SMEs that attract suitably qualified young entrepreneurs, managers and specialists, receive innovation funding and carry out R&D projects together with colleges/universities.

The project addresses the following secondary target groups (beneficiaries):

- a) colleges and universities which, in order to expand their educational opportunities in climate and environmental protection, receive all the documents and materials for two new dual bachelor's degree programs in order to meet the labour market needs and the conditions of SMEs in particular.
- b) chambers and other vocational training institutions which attract strong young people to vocational training, receive curricula for continuing vocational training modules for the qualification of SMEs and their staff, and cooperate intensively with colleges/universities in teaching and innovation promotion.
- c) teachers, advisers and lecturers from chambers, other VET providers and colleges/universities who are qualified in Train the Trainer programs to provide high-quality further training, to carry out dual study courses in cooperation with companies as well as innovation promotion and R&D projects for SMEs at a high-quality level.

1.3 About the Dissemination

All results of the project were transferred to 70 chambers, SME associations and colleges/universities from 11 countries, which received implementation advice and are involved in the project work as associated partners from the beginning of the project.

At the beginning of the project, the following were developed and agreed in the consortium:

- a) A strategic plan for the implementation of the dissemination activities on the project and its results.

b) A form to plan and record all dissemination activities including activities to be carried out, target groups, target numbers, deadlines, etc.

On this basis each partner made an initial planning of the activities. An update of the planning and a recording of the activities already carried out was made by each partner every year. The results achieved and the further plans were intensively discussed and agreed with all partners at the biannual project workshops.

2. Dissemination Strategy

2.1 Dissemination objectives

The dissemination strategy intends to ensure the effective communication and promotion of the project's goals, achievements, and results to the relevant stakeholders. The goal is to increase awareness and understanding of the project, as well as its impact and benefits on regional, national and EU-level. Moreover, the aim is to engage stakeholders in the project's activities and results, and to ensure that the project's achievements are sustained after the end of the funding period. Tailored dissemination measures are designed to disseminate the project activities and results to different target groups.

The concrete dissemination goals are to:

- **Promote** the ongoing trainings
- **Inform** about the results that will be publicly available
- **Engage** the different target groups to join trainings or to receive input and feedback
- **Make sustainable** all outputs and results also beyond the project lifetime

Overall, the dissemination strategy intends to maximize the impact and reach of the project and its results, both during and after the funding period.

PP1 Hanse Parliament will carry out the leadership for WP6 Dissemination, Implementation Consulting & Securing Permanent Continuation with the Results. All project partners will contribute with dissemination activities to the different stakeholders in their network.

2.2 Dissemination target groups

The BA&VET dissemination strategy plan targets a range of different stakeholders in order to effectively communicate the project's goals and achievements. The following are some of the key target groups that should be considered:

1. **Students** in VET education, entering VET education and higher education students: These groups are the primary target of the project as they are the direct beneficiaries of the project. The project's results and achievements should be communicated to them through various means such as website, brochures, reports, and articles, etc.

5. **Teachers** of VET and higher education institutions: These groups are important stakeholders as they are responsible for delivering vocational education and training and will benefit from the project's results.
6. **Vocational schools and Universities**: These groups are important stakeholders as they are responsible for delivering vocational education and training and higher education and will benefit from the project's results.
7. **National authorities**: The project's results and achievements should be communicated to national authorities. This can be done by using existing networks, such as vocational education and training organizations and SME associations, and by organizing events, such as workshops, seminars, and conferences.
8. **Regional authorities**: The project's results and achievements should be communicated to regional authorities. This can be done by using existing networks, such as vocational education and training organizations and SME associations, and by organizing events, such as workshops, seminars, and conferences.
9. **Local authorities**: The project's results and achievements should be communicated to local authorities. This can be done by using existing networks, such as vocational education and training organizations and SME associations, and by organizing events, such as workshops, seminars, and conferences.
10. **General public**: The project's results and achievements should be communicated to the general public. This can be done by using existing networks, such as vocational education and training organizations and SME associations, and by organizing events, such as workshops, seminars, and conferences.
11. **NGO's**: The project's results and achievements should be communicated to NGO's. This can be done by using existing networks, such as vocational education and training organizations and SME associations, and by organizing events, such as workshops, seminars, and conferences.

Moreover, all partners are encouraged to use their own websites as a dissemination channel for the BA&VET project.
2. **Social media:** Social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter, and LinkedIn are used to share project updates, news, and success stories to increase the visibility of the project and engage with stakeholders. All partners are encouraged to use their own social media accounts as a dissemination channel for the BA&VET project
3. **E-mails and E-Newsletters:** Regular newsletters and e-mails sent to stakeholders, including associated partners, national and regional authorities, SMEs, and teachers, to keep them informed about the project's progress and results.

3. Measures and results of dissemination activities

3.1 Result transfer and implementation consulting

Transfer target groups "Chambers of commerce, other SME promoters and other VET institutions

Chambers of commerce operating at regional and national level were a main target groups for dissemination activities. This is because they represent the interests of SMEs, bring in their needs, organize vocational education and training and take on the outstanding task of informing, qualifying and advising SMEs and supporting and promoting the implementation of the vocational training programmes developed, tested and evaluated.

The project involved

- a) two chambers and SME associations as project partners.
- b) 50 chambers of commerce and crafts and other SME funding institutions from 11 countries as associated partners. They were involved in the work from the beginning of the project, received all information and their suggestions, wishes and conditions were continuously fed into the project work.

Chambers and other SME funding institutions from regions in other countries were also approached and informed through further dissemination (see chapter 2) activities.

Transfer target groups "Colleges and Universities"

Another very important target group - also at regional level - were universities and colleges. They were instrumental in developing the curricula for the train-the-trainer programs, for two dual Bachelor programs and two further education programs. In the future, they will conduct the Train the Trainer program on an ongoing basis, so that the chambers will always have well-qualified teachers and advisors for the implementation and use of the project results. In addition, the colleges/universities will also implement the two new three-stage dual bachelor's degree programmes developed as part of the project.

Colleges/universities were also important target groups because they support the chambers in the implementation of the further training and counselling programs by using their own lecturers and counsellors.

The project involved:

- a) as project partners four colleges/university.
- b) 20 colleges and universities from 10 countries as associated partners. They were involved in the work from the beginning of the project, received all information and their suggestions, wishes and conditions were continuously fed into the project work.

Transfers and Implementations

The 70 associated partners (chambers, other SME promoters, colleges and universities) were informed intensively by PP1 HP as transfer recipients and implementation

partners in writing and online as part of their daily business, as well as in person at conferences, members' meetings, etc.; their suggestions were continuously fed into the project work. They were involved in the development work, so that it was not necessary to transfer third-party products, but customized programs that they had developed themselves.

To support and secure the development, transfer and implementation work, representatives of the transfer recipients took part in workshops. The developed products were practically tested, evaluated, improved and finalized. The subsequent dissemination to all project and associated partners took place through different channels:

- a) All concepts, tools, curricula, instructions for implementation etc. were made available in written and electronic form.
- b) Lecturers from project and associated partners were invited as observers to the trials so that they could gain experience for their own implementations.
- c) During the project period, the following events were held with the project and associated partners in Budapest in June 2023, in Riga in September 2024 and in Gdansk in September 2025.
 - three conferences to present and discuss the project and its results. These conferences were attended by a total of 284 people.
 - three half-day workshops to monitor the transfers carried out and, in particular, to advise on and plan implementations. These workshops were attended by a total of 131 people.
 - Project and associated partners received 2024 and 2025 individual implementation consultations as needed.


The aim of the project was to ensure that as many of the project and associated partners as possible use the study programs and training measures on a permanent basis and thus achieve very high participant numbers in the medium term. To ensure this, PP1 HP will continue to provide individual advice and support for implementation after the end of the project.

Over 500,000 SMEs are members of the chambers that participated as project and associated partners. As part of their day-to-day business, the chambers continuously approached their member companies and provided comprehensive information. In addition, the chambers continue to run the further educational programmes to promote and qualify their member SMEs. In addition, the chambers support colleges/universities in implementing dual study programmes, promoting innovation and carrying out R&D projects with and for SMEs.

In addition to the transfer and implementation of the project results, extensive dissemination activities were carried out according to the project proposal. Finally, eight result videos were produced and published and a large bundle of measures for the further dissemination of the project and its results were implemented. These activities are listed below with their results.

3.2 Further development and utilisation of project results by eight COVE

As part of the project 'Regional and International Education Partnerships for Workplace Innovation in SMEs' (WIN4SMEs), eight Centres of Vocational Excellence (COVE) will be established between 2024 and 2028. These will be jointly operated by chambers, vocational schools and colleges/universities and will develop and implement vocational training and further education as well as higher education (EQF Levels 3–7).



This was a stroke of luck for the BA&VET project, which developed an intensive cooperation with the eight COVEs. They took part in consultation conferences and workshops, received all the results of the BA&VET project and comprehensive implementation advice. The eight COVEs intend to permanently implement the two dual study programmes developed in the BA&VET project as well as the two continuing education programmes. The implementation of the continuing education programmes already began during the project period.

In addition, the eight COVEs are dedicated to further developing the BA&VET results. For example, the very large number of hours required for the continuing education programmes is a problem, as SMEs always suffer from a severe lack of time and participants are often unwilling to invest several hundred hours in continuing education. For this reason, two COVEs have developed a concept based on microcredit qualification certificates (CAS) for the continuing education programme 'Commercial Specialist in Sustainable Management', which comprises over 700 teaching hours. This concept is currently being tested by all eight COVEs.

The eight COVEs are also involved in new developments. For example, a dual Bachelor's degree programme in 'Human Resources and Business Administration' has been newly developed and is currently being tested by individual COVEs. Another COVE is

currently developing a trial Bachelor's degree programme with integrated vocational training and further training in workplace innovation.

3.3 Measures and results of further dissemination

The activities carried out and the results achieved are briefly summarised below. The dissemination activities carried out by all partners and the results achieved are summarised in Chapter "Measures of further dissemination activities of all project partners".

Dissemination planning

The project proposal envisaged the implementation of the following further dissemination measures:

- a) All results, materials, etc. will be posted on publicly accessible internet platforms and on the websites of the project partners.
- b) At least four press conferences and at least six press releases will provide intensive information on project results and their use.
- c) Ongoing information by all project and associated partners on their own platforms and in member magazines.
- d) Project and associated partners bring project results into political decision-making processes as part of their day-to-day business and support work-based learning in particular.
- e) At least 18 events organised by third parties, project results, possibilities of use etc. are presented in person in different countries.
- f) As an international organisation, PP1 is involved in numerous political bodies and will inform them about project goals and results in order to further promote their inclusion in political decision-making processes.

To realise these activities, a communication and dissemination plan was developed and agreed with each project partner at the beginning of the project, including activities to be carried out, target groups, target numbers, deadlines, etc. These plans were actualised with the actual results achieved and the plannings were updated as of

- 31 March 2023,
- 30 November 2024 and
- the end of the project on 30 November 2025.

The results achieved and the further plans were intensively discussed and agreed with all partners at the biannual project workshops.

The results achieved in the further dissemination measures far exceed the plans of the project application. They are documented in chapter "Measures of further dissemination activities of all project partners" and are briefly summarised below.

Presentation on third party's events

Planning application: At least 18 third-party events, project results, possibilities of use, etc. are presented in person in different countries.

Realizations: At a total of 49 events, the project and its results were personally presented, advised and implementations planned. Thus, a very large number of target groups of the project, future users of the project results as well as stakeholders could be addressed on a broad international basis. More than 3,000 people were addressed and informed.

Information on websites, in social media, newsletters, press releases

Planning application: All results, materials, etc. will be posted on a project website and on three publicly accessible platforms as well as on all partner portals and disseminated via social media.

Realizations: In addition to the project website, all partner websites as well as websites of associated and cooperation partners continuously reported on the project and published results. All partners made intensive use of social media (Facebook, LinkedIn, YouTube, etc.). In addition, some partners realised direct e-mail campaigns with a very high number of addresses. In total, more than 40,000 people were reached. Compared to the planning, twice the number of press releases were issued, and press conferences and talks were held, so that extensive publications in the general and trade press were achieved.

Publications in partner journals, books, printed newsletter

Planning Application: At least four press conferences and at least six press releases provide intensive information about project results and their use. In addition, all partners provide information on an ongoing basis in their own publications.

Realization: Compared to the planning, twice the number of press releases were issued, and press conferences and talks were held, so that extensive publications in the general and specialised press were achieved. A larger number of newsletters were issued and project contributions for third-party newsletters were written and published. Articles on project results were written and published in trade journals, magazines and other media. Partners have produced and distributed flyers and brochures. different publications were produced and published. Some partners have participated in radio and television broadcasts and have achieved wide dissemination of the project.

Introduction of project results in policies, administrations, stakeholders etc.

Planning application: Project partners introduce project results into political decision-making processes as part of their day-to-day business, as well as ongoing introduction of results into official bodies, in particular of politics and administrations.

Realizations: Chambers and associations and also other partners have intensively used their official membership in political and administrative bodies at regional, national and international level to introduce project results into consultation and decision-making processes, to comprehensively inform stakeholders from politics and administration and to achieve promotion and dissemination. Different institutions were involved and more than 500 stakeholders were addressed. With a total of 415 policies, administrations and stakeholders, three international conferences and three workshops were held.

Disseminations to national and international umbrella organizations

Planning application: All project partners will contribute the project and its results intensively to national and international umbrella organisations, making extensive use of their memberships in such organisations and their international collaborations.

Realizations: All partners have comprehensively informed their national and international umbrella organisations, transferred project results and achieved strong dissemination. Different institutions were involved, and a large number of stakeholders were addressed.

Other activities

Planning in the application: None

Realizations: Individual partners have carried out additional specific dissemination activities, for example:

- Specific information and dissemination activities for key stakeholders.
- Holding online conferences and transnational video conferences to disseminate project results.
- Conducting meetings with owners and managers of SMEs.
- Intensive use of personal and business contacts for dissemination purposes.
- Creation of various videos provided and used for dissemination activities of all partners
- International cooperation activities of universities

The videos were published on the YouTube Chanel of the lead partner Hanse-Parlament, on the project website and on the websites of the project partners. The result videos could of course only be created towards the end of the project. However, they have already proven to be a very effective information and dissemination tool. They are also used by the project and associated partners to provide information about the project as a whole and in particular about individual educational programs, to address target groups and to win participant.

3.4 Conclusions

All activities planned in the project proposal for the further dissemination of the project and its results were realised. The target figures of the project proposal were exceeded to a very large extent. 70 chambers, other vocational training institutions and colleges/universities from 11 countries were involved in the project work as associated partners and received all project results as well as comprehensive implementation advice. With the permanent implementation of the project results, over 500,000 SMEs that are members of the participating chambers will be reached in the medium term. All project results will also be used on a permanent basis and further developed in line with requirements by eight Centres of Vocational Excellence, with which the BA&VET project has established intensive cooperation that will continue after the end of the project.

In addition to the transfers and implementations, outstanding results were achieved in further dissemination through the great commitment of all project partners in all partner and other EU countries.

In addition to the planning of the project proposal, eight result videos were produced and published on the websites of the project and the partners as well as on the YouTube channel of the lead partner. They contribute decisively to the outstanding success of the dissemination of the results of the BA&VET project.

In addition, special dissemination measures were developed and in connection with the testing and implementation of Bachelor and training programmes, which represent an optimal complement to the qualifications and at the same time led to a strong dissemination of the project results, in particular also strongly promote the feeding of the results into decision-making processes of politics and administration. Some of these dissemination measures have led to follow-up activities that will be realised after the end of the project.

Just like the transfers and implementation consultations (see Chapter “Result transfer and implementation consulting”), the activities of further dissemination will also be continued after the end of the project.
